The ESC Höchststadt e.V. extends with great pleasure an invitation to all eligible synchronized skating teams to participate in the

4th Bavaria Cup

incl. "Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen"

(for all German Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Non ISU Basic Novice, Mixed Age, Adult and Masters Teams)

The event will take place on **20th and 21st of March 2027** at the ice rink in Höchststadt an der Aisch

(Kieferndorfer Weg 77 / 91315 Höchststadt / Germany) and will include the following categories:

Non ISU Categories: Pre-Juvenile / Juvenile / Non ISU Basic Novice / Mixed Age / Adult / ISU Adult / Masters / ISU Masters / Junior B / Senior B

ISU Categories: ISU Advanced Novice / ISU Junior / ISU Senior / ISU Senior Elite 12

General rules

The international synchronized skating competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, current Competition & Event Regulations (CER), the Sports Rules Synchronized Skating 2026, and all relevant ISU Communications. For ISU Adult Figure Skating Competitions Season 2026-2027. Participation in Bavaria Cup open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to CER Article 7.2, provided their ages fall within the limits specified and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Article 8 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

All programs will be judged in accordance with the ISU Communications 2779, 2791 and 2787. The Well Balanced Programs for the categories Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile and Non ISU Basic Novice coincide with the category ISU Basic Novice. The Well Balanced Program for the Adult and Masters categories coincides with the Technical Requirements for Synchronized Skating for ISU Adult Figure Skating Competitions Season 2026-2027. The Well Balanced Program for the category Mixed Age follows the General rules for the Junior category. The Well Balanced Programs for the categories Junior and Senior as well as Junior B (only free skating) and Senior B (only free skating) coincide with the respective ISU categories Junior and Senior.

Categories and technical requirements

Please note: The 80/20%, 75/25% and 50/50% rules mentioned as follows apply only to the competing skaters on the ice (excluding alternate skaters).

Pre-Juvenile shall consist of 8 - 16 (eight to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 11 (eleven) before 1st July, 2026. A maximum of 25% may be outside the age criteria of the category with a maximum of 2 (two) years.

Free skating program **3.00 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Please note: Elements of the highest level can be performed, but a maximum of Level 2 will be called. For the synchronized spin element (SySp), a maximum of level 1 will be called.
(according to DFBest.DKBSYS)

At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 13 (thirteen) before 1st July, 2026. A maximum of 25% may be outside the age criteria of the category with a maximum of 2 (two) years.

Free skating program **3.00 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Please note: Elements of the highest level can be performed, but a maximum of Level 3 will be called. For the synchronized spin element (SySp), a maximum of level 1 will be called.

Non ISU Basic Novice shall consist of 8 - 16 (eight to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. They must have reached at least the age of 10 (ten) before 1st July 2026 and not have reached the age of 16 (sixteen) before 1st July, 2026. At least 75% of the skaters must meet the age category. A maximum of 25% may be outside the age criteria of the category with a maximum of +/- 2 (two) years.

Mixed Age shall consist of 8 - 16 (eight to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters, no age limit.

Free skating program **3.30 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Adult / Masters shall consist of 8 - 16 (eight to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them (including alternate skaters) must have reached at least the age of 18 (eighteen) before 1st July 2026. At least 50% must have reached the age of 23 (twentythree) before 1st July 2026.

Free skating program **3.00 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **1.67**

ISU Adult / ISU Masters (ISU age rules) shall consist of 12 - 16 (twelve to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least three quarters (75%) of team members (not including reserves) must have reached the age of 28 (twenty-eight) before 1st July 2026. A maximum of one quarter (25%) of the team members must have reached at least the age of 25 (twenty-five) before 1st July 2026.

Free skating program **3.00 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **1.67**

ISU shall consist of 9 - 16 (nine to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 10 (ten) before 1st July 2026, but not have reached the age of 16 (sixteen) before 1st July 2026. In case of an injury or illness of a skater during the official practice or competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 7 (seven) skaters.

Free skating **3.00 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Junior shall consist of 12 - 16 (twelve to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 13 (thirteen) before 1st July 2026, but not have reached the age of 19 (nineteen) before July 1st, 2026. In case of an injury or illness of a skater during the official practice or competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 (eleven) skaters.

Short program **2.50 min** (may be less) / program components factor **1.33**

Free skating program **3.30 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Junior B shall consist of 12 - 16 (twelve to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 13 (thirteen) before 1st July 2026, but not have reached the age of 19 (nineteen) before July 1st, 2026. In case of an injury or illness of a skater during the official practice or competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 (eleven) skaters. A maximum of 20% may be outside the age criteria of the category with a maximum of +/- 2 (two) years.

The Junior B competition consists of a free skating program only.

Free skating program **3.30 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Senior shall consist of 12 - 16 (twelve to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 17 (seventeen) before 1st July, 2026. In case of an injury or illness of a skater during the official practice or competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 (eleven) skaters.

Short program **2.50 min** (may be less) / program components factor **1.33**

Free skating program **4.00 min** (+ / - 10 sec) / program components factor **2.67**

Senior B shall consist of 12 - 16 (twelve to sixteen) skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 17 (seventeen) before 1st July, 2026. In case of an injury or illness of a skater during the official practice or competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 (eleven) skaters. A maximum of 20% may be outside the age criteria of the category with a maximum of - 2 (two) years.

Pre-Entry and Final Registration

All entries have to be submitted to the organizing committee (OC) of the Bavaria Cup.

All teams who want to participate in the BavariaCup 2027 have to pre-register in advance. Pre-entries have to be done by October 31st, 2026.

Following the pre-registration deadline an online registration link will be provided to the team managers of all pre-registered teams. (Please note: Pre-registrations after the deadline can only be accepted if there are still starting places available.)

The final registrations must be submitted no later than November 30th, 2026.

Entry fees

The fixed entry fees for the 3rd Bavaria Cup 2027 will be

- **600,- Euro** for Senior and Junior teams
(categories with short program and free skating)
- **550,- Euro** for all other participating categories.

The due date for the entry fee payment is **November 30th, 2026** and has to be transferred to the following bank account:

After the final registration, each team will receive an invoice with the payment summary.

Please take note of the following: The entry fee payment does not include extra practice ice nor any offered meals at the competition. Should a team withdraw from the event after that date, the amount will not be returned.

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of teams per category or country, refuse entry or cancel a category (in case that only a few teams register in a category). This will only be decided if necessary, and will be at the discretion of the OC only. The OC reserves the right to cancel the competition on short notice, due to the decisions of the national authorities and international travel restrictions. In case of cancellation before December 31st, 2026, the OC will refund the participation fee at 100%. In case of cancellation after December 31st, 2026, the OC will refund the participation fee at 90%.

Judges and Technical Panel

The competition will be judged under the ISU system. Panel of judges for each competition will consist of (if possible):

- 1 Referee,
- 1 Referee's Assistant Ice Level,
- 5 Judges,
- 1 Technical Controller,
- 2 Technical Specialists,
- 2 Data/Replay Operator.

Each participating ISU member may nominate 1 (one) judge. The entries of judges must be made not later than **Sunday November 30th, 2026**.

Travel expenses, accommodation and meals will be paid for the invited technical panel, the referees and the nominated and invited judges by the OC. The transportation between airport, station hotel and ice rink is granted to the technical panel, referees and judges.

PPC

The planned program content (PPC) must be sent to the OC by **November 30th, 2026** at latest. It is mandatory that the PPC is filled through the online entry system precisely by each team in English, using the terminology for the elements listed in the Scale of Value Table published in ISU Com. 2776.

Music

All teams are asked to send their music information in advance and have to provide their competition music of excellent quality by **November 30th, 2026** at latest. Please upload the music as **MP3-file** via our online registration tool. The file must be clearly identified and should be labelled in the format:

"category_team name_free skating or short program_exact duration of the program".

Additionally, each team shall bring along a labelled USB-Stick with the music of their short program and/or free skating.

Teamphoto

Teams are asked to enclose to their final registration a current digital team photo, in **high-resolution** printing quality, please. The teamphoto has to be uploaded via the online registration tool.

Draw

The starting order for the competition will be drawn prior to the competition on **Sunday March 14th, 2027** in the presence of the referee of the BavariaCup 2027. The results of the draw will be published no later than **Sunday March 14th, 2027** at 24:00 on the competition website www.bavariacup.eu.

Registration

The registration for referees, judges, technical controllers, technical specialists, data/replay operators, teams, accredited coaches, team leaders and team managers will take place at the designated registration office at the ice rink in Höchststadt on Friday, **March 19th starting at 12pm to 6pm and on Saturday/Sunday, March 20/21, 2027 from 6am**. Team managers are requested to bring copies of the passports or identity cards (EU citizens only) of all registered skaters of their teams to the registration office.

Official practice ice

The official practice will start on **Saturday and Sunday, March 20th and 21st, 2027** approximately around 7am (the schedule is subjected to change!). Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Non ISU Basic Novice, Advanced Novice, Adult and Masters Teams team will be allowed a 10 (ten) minute period of official practice ice. Mixed Age and Junior teams will be allowed an 11 (eleven) and Senior and Senior Elite 12 teams a 12 (twelve) minute period for their official practice ice for their free skating. Junior, Senior and Senior Elite 12 teams will be allowed a 10 (ten) minute period for their official practice ice for their short program. The official practice is already included in the entry fee. No other music but short program and free skating music will be played during the official practice segments. Once the music has started (after 1 minute and 30 seconds at the latest) it will be played through in its entirety with no interruption. The music will be played twice during each official practice session.

Unofficial practice ice

Teams requiring extra practice ice are requested to make a reservation via the online final registration tool no later than **November 30th, 2026** including the preferred time slots. Depending on the demand, the OC of the Bavaria Cup reserves the right to arrange the time slots for each team accordingly.

Extra practice ice will be available on **Friday March 19th, 2027**. The OC will charge **60€ per 15 minutes** on the ice. The confirmation of the fixed time slot for the extra practice session will be sent to the respective teams via email.

Special Requirements "Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen"

The German Figure Skating Federation, Deutsche Eislauf-Union e.V., is assigning the second "Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen" to the OC of Bavaria Cup 2027 in order to host the competition within the mentioned event. "Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen" will be conducted under the rules of the German Figure Skating Federation, specifically: OAB, DKB, DFBest.DKBSYS.

Please note regarding the **final scoring of “Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen”**:

Only German teams from the following categories will be included:

Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Non ISU Basic Novice, Mixed Age, Adult and Masters

No extra registration is necessary for the “Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen”. The “Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen” is scored within the Bavaria Cup competition, i.e., the order of the German Non-ISU teams in the respective category of the Bavaria Cup corresponds to the final ranking of the “Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen”.

Notice: The categories **Adult & ISU Adult** as well as **Masters & ISU Masters** will each be conducted in one competition (see technical requirements). As all ISU Adult and ISU Masters teams automatically fulfil the age requirements for the Adult and Masters category, the **German teams results will count towards the final scoring of “Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen”**

Awards

For the **Bavaria Cup 2027**: Trophies will be presented to the first, second, and third place in each category, all skaters will be awarded medals and all teams will receive a certificate of participation.

In addition, separate awards will be given to the competitors of **“Deutschlandpokal Synchroneiskunstlaufen”**.

Hotel & accommodation

Höchstadt is located near the franconian cities of Nuremberg, Erlangen, Herzogenaurach, Forchheim and Bamberg. If you would like assistance in finding a place to stay in one of the cities or in the countryside around Höchstadt you are welcome to have a look on our homepage (www.bavariacup.eu) where we will soon publish a **list of hotels** sorted by distance and number of rooms. We are in contact with some providers and would be happy if we could make your journey a little easier, **but we ask you to look for a suitable hotel as early as possible. We recommend especially sports clubs that travel with several teams to take care of a hotel in time (preferably still in 2026), so that all can stay together in one hotel.**

Ice rink and transportation

The ice rink in Höchstadt a. d. Aisch is located at Kieferndorfer Weg 77, not far from the town center of Höchstadt. Easy to be reached: 5 minutes by car from the highway exit (highway A3 #80). The nearby larger cities of Nuremberg, Erlangen or Forchheim are only a 20 to 30 minute drive away. Nuremberg has an international airport NUE (www.airport-nuernberg.de/english). For teams needing transportation between the airport, hotel and rink, we also publish a list of local bus companies and their contact information on our website (www.bavariacup.eu). **Please reserve a bus shuttle in time.**

Teams arriving by bus may use the designated bus parking area nearby the ice rink. The ice rink in Höchstadt an der Aisch has been comprehensively modernized in the last two years and is now fully equipped to meet contemporary standards for athletes and spectators alike. With a total capacity of 2,000 visitors and an ice surface measuring 29.7 by 59.7 meters, the facility now offers significantly improved infrastructure, comfort and is now heated. The renovation project, carried out between the

winter of 2023 and the 2024/2025 season, included the installation of a new roof, full enclosure of the rink, and the implementation of modern ice technology. With all planned measures now successfully completed, the venue provides a high-quality, energy-efficient environment for ice sport competitions.

Meals

Lunch and dinner will be provided for the teams during the competition. After the final registration all respective teams will be contacted via Email by the OC regarding a pre-reservation and further information. Payment for the meals has to be placed directly at the restaurant to the caterer.

Judges Meeting

The Judges and Technical Panel Meeting will be held on **Friday March 19th, 2027 at 18.00** at the official judges hotel.

Medical information

Each team manager should be able to give important medical information for each skater of the team in case of an emergency or accident. Such information should include but is not limited to the following, and will greatly help local medical and emergency personnel: allergies, existing medical conditions (i.e. asthma), current medications, immunizations, blood type, use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances.

Liability

In accordance with ISU rule 119 p2, the ESC e.V. (organizer) accepts no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors or officials. The organizer will not provide participant insurance coverage for the event. Each club or team is expected to provide its own insurance protection. The organizer will provide emergency medical services for all participants during the competition and official practice.

Publicity waiver

Each individual/team waives any and all rights to financial refund or other compensation for the use and reproduction of their images or likeness, and grants permission to the OC of the competition to use the same prior to, during and following the Bavaria Cup in Höchststadt a.d. Aisch, Germany.

Tickets

The Bavaria Cup is **free of charge** to all visitors in order to highlight and promote this international synchronized skating competition in Bavaria.
